## DOCUMENTS NEEDED:

- 1 Submit originals or certified copies of all marked sheets, transcripts, diplomas and certificates from high school (Secondary and prep school) or other academic institutions. Official translations must be provided when originals are not in English. Your high school GPA should be more than a 2.5 out of 4 or 70%.
- 2 Copy of your passport.
- 3 Copy of your personal family bank statement.
- 4 Copy of your medical forms and inoculations for measles, mumps, rubella, TB skin test, and chicken Pox. A letter from your doctor will be sufficient (it will need to be translated into English).
- 5 Proof of English Language Proficiency  
ELS Level 109, IBT 61+, IELTS 5.5+, TOEIC 600+, Duolingo 95+, Pearson's 50+, CEFR B1, B2, C1, C2 +
